	D. Lerch stated that he had received a quote at the government rate by Wittmeier Honda in

Chico for a CRV at \$25,000.00, but that he has not received approval from the state for the purchase and is waiting to hear from Neil Kelly. There is a question as to exact amount of

carryover funds due to indirect costs that are being assessed by FRC that were not previously accounted for.

W. Jackson asked if the discussion regarding amounts were still going to be the same with \$5,000.00 being allocated for Go Teach and the remainder split between FRC and Sierra County.

D. Lerch replied FRC would purchase first and the remainder would be sent to Sierra County.

M. Grant stated that he hoped that a minimum of \$20,000.00 be directed to Sierra County for the purchase.

W. Jackson asked if the remainder of the funds for the vehicle purchase could be allocated from the 18-19 allocation funds that will be carry-over from PCOE.

K. Warren stated she felt Sierra should spend all their allocation first.

D. Lerch stated that in preparing for the future not all funding should be spent every year and some amount of carry-over is a sound fiscal practice.

K. Warren amended motion so that FRC vehicle purchase is contingent upon state approval; 2<sup>nd</sup> by M. Grant

W. Jackson clarified that Sierra County will move forward as state approval for Sierra County has already been received.

State approval for FRC vehicle purchase will be an information item on a future FRAEC Board Agenda and documentation will be provided in the FRAEC Board Packet.
